toymaker who deeply understood children and what the core of Montessori is about - serving the light of the child.

Andy would not merely fix something, he may also embellish it. He would hide little gold coins in the sandbox for children to find. He would make small toys from scrap wood and gift them to those who seemed to need them. On Halloween, he would dress as the Purple Pirate to the children's delight. He would hold circle times about either art or the items in his indigenous medicine bag. His gifts were precious and rare.
