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## Message from Jayne

We are so thankful to have a strong family community at DVMS. Our campus is like a second home for the children, both current and older siblings and therefore, very familiar. As a licensed facility under the Department of Social Services, we also need to be mindful of licensing requirements, particularly with respect to proper supervision of children.

All children must be under the visual supervision of a parent or teacher at all times. This includes the parking lot and playgrounds. Please never leave a child unattended in a car. Similarly, the playgrounds are for current DVMS students while a teacher is present. If an older sibling is coming along to drop off or pick up your child, they need to stay with their parent or supervising adult.

The responsibility of supervision also relates to the signing in and out procedures. Entering a PIN to check your child in or out signals the transfer of responsibility. This is especially important for parents with children in both the IT House and Preschool/Kindergarten programs. Each child needs to be signed in and out at their respective program.

Thank you for your partnership in ensuring the safety and supervision of our children.
