
Back to the 80s Auction for DVMS

Looking Ahead: Spring, Summer, and the 2022-2023 School Year

Enrollment Season is here and with it comes many questions. To help, here are a few answers to some common questions we have received this week:

1. If my child is not returning to DVMS, do I need to fill out the form? Yes. We appreciate confirmation of your decision and will miss them!

2. If my current DVMS student is not returning but I have a child in the wait pool, do I complete the form?

Yes. Please indicate the program choice for all of your children. All children must have a current application on file to be considered for enrollment.

3. My child is in IT House. What program should I select for August? Reach out to your child's classroom teachers. They will be happy to guide you in your selection.

4. Why are all of the other forms I filled out earlier this year in my Portal? Please ignore the forms such as the 2021-2022 enrollment, extended care request, photo release etc. We are working with our database provider and hope to have this system glitch corrected soon.

5. What about Summer School for preschool?

Summer school for the 3-6 year classes will be offered in 2-week increments beginning on June 6 and run until July 29. Information on session themes and enrollment coming in March.

6. Will there be extended care during Parent-Teacher conferences and Spring Break? Yes, on a limited, first-come, first-served basis. Sign up forms will be available later in February, with plenty of notice so you don't miss out.
