Re-Enrollment

Re-enrollment for 2023-2024 is underway. Please be sure to complete the form in detail noting your intent for your currently enrolled child(ren) as well as siblings. Even if your child is not returning, please submit the form with the appropriate section completed. To ensure siblings are considered for placement, an

application must be on file. Our web site is updated with the 2023-2024 calendar and summary of all program fees for your reference.

To secure your child's spot for 2023-2024, make sure to complete the form no later than February 22.

Extended Care Sign Ups

In March, the second Parent-Teachers conferences are taking place from the 21st through the 24th. During these days, all children except for the Sunflower class are dismissed before lunchtime. Extended care is available on a limited basis with spots given on a first-come first-served basis. The form to request extended care during conference week will be available at 11 am on Tuesday, February 28.

Spring Break, for Buttercup and Preschool/Kindergarten classes is the first week of April, (the 3rd to the 7th). Limited extended care for Preschool/Kindergarten children may be available. Sign ups and schedules for that care will open at 11am on Monday, March 6.

Parking Lot Grace and Courtesy

The DVMS parking lot is small and busy! Morning drop off time can be particularly challenging. The children need to get to class, older siblings need to get to their school, and parents need to get to work. To ensure that everyone gets where the need to go in a timely, and safe, manner, please be mindful of the following guidelines (as described in the Parent Handbook):

- *Make a quick get-a-way: respect the 10 minute parking signs. This is not the time to play with your child or check your email while sitting in your car.
- * Make space: when lining up for morning carpool drop off, move to the right, making space for cars to pass on your left.
- * If utilizing carpool drop off, this is not the time to help your child put on their coat, backpack, or fix their hair. Please be quick and mindful of cars behind you.
- * Only park in designated spaces. The western entrance must remain clear for both incoming and departing traffic.
- *Please do not line up for car pool prior to 8:35 am or 11:40 am. Doing so prevents parents dropping in our two year old half day class from parking and exiting our lot.


Class Fund-a-Need
