COVID and Masking Update

During the month of May, DVMS experienced the most cases of COVID to date. Thankfully all cases were mild and everyone is back at DVMS! There have not been any new cases since the end of the school year to report.

With the good news of no new cases, Contra Costa Health closed the DVMS case file.

Effective June 10th, DVMS will be mask optional in both indoor and outdoor settings. Please understand that is it is still strongly recommended for individuals to wear a proper fitting mask while in certain indoor environments, child care included. If there is another outbreak of COVID cases, we will revisit this decision.

As part of the DVMS community, we trust that all families follow the health policy. Keeping the children and staff healthy allows us to serve everyone. If your child is experiencing any signs of illness, please keep them home to rest. If anyone in your household tests positive for COVID-19, notify DVMS immediately.
