COVID and Masking Updates

Since the beginning of March, there have been many developments in California's approach to COVID-19. This pandemic has changed our lives and impacted how we care for our families and each other. In the past two weeks I have attended a variety of sessions with the California Department of Health, Contra Costa Health, and Community Care Licensing. All three organizations are aligned in how we move forward. COVID-19 is not going away, however we know so much more and have many more resources to protect our communities.

As a childcare program we must continue to take all necessary precautions to minimize the spread of COVID-19. Keeping the children and staff safe is our top priority. Access to testing, vaccines, mask wearing, cleaning protocols, and proper ventilation have all helped mitigate the risk and transmission of the virus.

The universal mask mandate for schools and childcare ends at the end of day today, March 11. Effective March 12, the California Department of Health (CDPH) and the California Department of Social Services, both of which oversee Licensing, "strongly recommend" that all individuals continue to wear a mask indoors. CDC data shows that mask wearing lowers the odds of contracting and transmitting COVID-19 by 56%-83%, (depending on the type of mask such as cloth or N95). As the majority of our children remain ineligible for the vaccine, masks are a significant tool to help reduce illness.

The decision to continue wearing a mask is complicated and requires a thoughtful approach. Setting aside concerns over the transmission of illness, there are many factors to consider. The children's social emotional and language development are vitally important to consider. Additionally, everyone can also agree that we are all ready to smile at one another!

I have asked our staff as well as several childcare providers about their opinions and policies on this issue in addition to further research. Many parents have shared about perspectives and I welcome you to share your ideas.

On Tuesday, March 22, the DVMS Board of Directors will discuss any changes to the current DVMS masking policy based on information and feedback gathered from resources in our community.

So until further notice, the DVMS masking policy remains unchanged. Masks are required for all adults when onsite with the children at DVMS, (within the gates). Children may remove their masks while playing outdoors. Staff members may choose to be unmasked while outdoors when they are not in close proximity to the children.

Thank you for your support and patience as we all navigate this next chapter of COVID together.
