

*Parents may attend this event in person. Due to limited space around the soccer field, please understand that this is a <u>parents only</u> event. Grandparents, older siblings, and other family members can enjoy your pictures and videos at home.

*PARK OFF CAMPUS due to the fact that our parking lot cannot accommodate so many cars at one time. Only staff and designated volunteers with Parking passes will be allowed to park on campus the day of the event.

*Parking is not permitted anywhere in our neighbor's lot, (the gray house).

*Please be respectful when parking on side streets. We strongly recommend carpooling and parking in designated spaces along Brown Avenue and into downtown Lafayette. It should be a pleasant morning for a walk!


*Costume Guidelines: no weapons, no masks. If your child's costume includes these items, they may wear the costume, but leave the mask and weapon portion at home. For example, a ninja could wear the clothing, but not the mask or bring the sword or ninja stars. Be sure to label costume pieces as we don't want any parts to be left behind and not make it out to trick-or- treating later that evening!

*With parents being allowed at the event this year you can be sure some children will have a hard time saying goodbye as all parents exit after the parade. If your child sees you and has a hard time

recovering it may be a good idea to consider taking your child home after the parade. If this is something you anticipate please let your classroom teachers know so we can prepare your child.

ALL CHILDREN MUST RETURN TO THEIR CLASSROOM AFTER THE PARADE regardless of pick up time. All children must be signed out through the office if they are leaving prior to their usual time. Jayne and Melissa will be available to sign out and collect children that may be leaving early. Again, please let your classroom teachers know if this is your plan.


