As we move into the fall months, cold and flu season is here. This year we are seeing an increase in respiratory illnesses including Respiratory Syncytial Virus, (RSV) which can be very serious for young children. I spoke with Contra Costa Health today. They anticipate a difficult season ahead and advised us to "buckle up". Our children have not had the opportunity to develop as many natural immunities due to sheltering in place in the early COVID months, resulting in higher rates of illness now. Our classrooms continue to follow the COVID cleaning protocols so be assured that we are doing our best to mitigate any illnesses.

Following the DVMS Health Policy is essential to keep our children and teachers healthy. We rely on families to do their part to keep DVMS safe too. A negative COVID test does not mean your child is well enough to attend school. There are a whole range of illnesses that we need to be concerned about. If your child is ill, keeping them home to rest for a day or two allows them to recover fully. It also shows consideration for the other children and staff by reducing the spread of illness to others.

Attached is this month's AMS Family Connect publication. I encourage you to read more about the philosophy of why we have mixed aged classrooms and the importance of teaching our children practical life skills, even at the earliest of ages.




