This week's extreme heat wave has certainly created opportunities to adapt the children's routines! Early morning outside time, lots of water play, and quiet afternoons have been fun for the children as we try to stay cool. The teachers are monitoring hydration levels and watching for any signs of heat-related illness.

We are also keeping a close eye on indoor temperatures. As a licensed facility, classrooms must be at least 68 degrees and no more than 85 degrees. While our air conditioners are running on high, with more fans to help circulate a breeze, some of our classrooms are struggling to stay cool. Thank you to all Infant Toddler families who have picked the children up early this week. Our teachers are grateful for your support! We appreciate your partnership in keeping everyone healthy and safe.

#### Special Pick Up Reminder

Occasionally there may be a need to pick your child up early for an appointment or family commitment. In this case, we ask that you:

- 1. Email your classroom teachers well in advance of your plans. This is important so they can plan around the routines and have your child ready.
- 2. Buttercup and Preschool families: come to the office to sign your child out. We will call the class to have your child meet you in front of the office.

### <u>Looking ahead to October - Picture and Conference Days</u>

Believe it or not, October is just around the corner. There are some dates to note in your calendars. In the coming weeks, look for an email about your child's class and individual picture day, (October 5-7).

Be sure to make plans for the week of October 10. On Monday the 10th, the staff has an in-service day. All classes are closed to children that day. From Tuesday the 11th through Friday the 14th, classes will be half-day to accommodate Parent-Teacher conferences in the afternoons.

- \*Buttercup and Half-day preschool children will be picked up at their regular time
- \*Preschool Lunch Bunch will not be scheduled
- \*All children in Poppy, Wildflower, Petunia, Jasmin, Honeysuckle (school day), and Daisy (extended day) will need to sign up for extended care if you wish for them to stay until 3pm or 5pm. The sign up for this extended care will be available later this month. Spots are limited!
- \*Sunflower children attend with their regular schedule
